

# Chesham Preparatory School YEARS 3, 4, 5 & 6 - Academic Year 2023/2024

# UNIFORM POLICY (full uniform list overleaf)

We at Chesham Preparatory School are proud of our pupils and want them to be identified as members of our school community

#### **General appearance**

All pupils from Nursery to Year 6 should wear the correct uniform without modifications either in colour or content. Our expectation is that the uniform is smart with shirts and blouses tucked in, and top buttons and ties done up. Shirts with Velcro fastenings are not permitted.

Pupils should arrive and depart from school properly dressed.

### Hair and make-up

Hair should be neat and tidy and kept off the face. If hair is longer than shoulder length, it should be neatly tied up. Hair fastenings must be either navy or royal blue and discreet without embellishment. They must only be used to keep hair in place. The use of both hair gel and hair dye is not permitted.

Pupils are not permitted to wear make-up or nail varnish. Similarly, the use of temporary transfers or fake tattoos is not allowed.

### **Jewellery**

The wearing of jewellery is prohibited on health and safety grounds. If a child wishes to have his/her ears pierced, we ask that this be carried out at the beginning of the summer holiday so that the healing process is complete by the start of the autumn term in September and the ear studs can be removed.

#### **Footwear**

Shoes should be of good quality, with heels no more than 3cm. They should be plain black and polishable. Trainers are not in keeping with the smart appearance of our usual school uniform and should only be worn as part of the school PE kit on designated days. Wellingtons/snow boots may be worn to and from school during bad weather but shoes must be brought in and worn during the day.
